- 1. Participants must have achieved a minimum of 5 consecutive superiors at the Juniors Festival
- 2. The student must have performed in the afternoon recital after achieving 3 consecutive years
- 3. The student must have performed at the district conference after achieving 4 consecutive superiors
- 4. The student may perform every year, if he or she wishes to do so, if the student continues to earn superior at the junior's festival.
- 5. First place winner may not compete again in the same level the following year but may compete in the higher event.
- 6. Students who enter in multiple events in the festival must choose which one instrument to play

These forms must be sent postmark no later than September 15 to Junior Competition Chairman

- 7. The student must provide his or her music for the judges. No photo copies will be allowed.
- 8. The selection of piece must not exceed 5 minutes

The morning meeting was on the budget headed by budget chairman **Ron Marenchin**. **Diane Larochelle** reported a balance of \$9,908.43 as of June 30, compared to last year's balance of \$6,787.80. The college and senior account finished up with a balance of \$14,481.27 as of June 30 compared to June 30, 2017 which ended with a balance of \$11,252.08.
