

Virtual 2020 Summer Music Camps

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RULES for The Ohio Federation of Music Clubs Summer Music Camp Awards

OFMC has twenty \$300.00 scholarships to give to students who have participated in OFMC festivals to attend these ONLINE Summer Music Camps at universities in Ohio whose music departments are members of OFMC. Entrants must be in grades 7– 12 who have achieved three or more consecutive years of superior ratings at their festival.

They must be in Moderately Difficult level or above in piano, Medium level or above in strings and Medium Class II or above for flute. Students must belong to a Junior Club of their teacher's studio or have paid \$13 to be an OFMC individual member.

\$300.00 should be deducted from the cost of the tuition. OFMC will pay the \$300. scholarship to the university AFTER the student attends the camp.

The students may participate in an event different from the event in which they performed at their Festival.
