Rules

Applicant Eligibility:

1. Age 19-26 and may not enter if 27th birthday is prior to competition deadline.
2. Enrolled as a music major in a college or university that is affiliated with OFMC.
3. The previous winner may not enter again the following year.

Award:

1. A \$1,500 prize will be awarded to the winner. The award will be determined by the judges whose decision is final. No winner will be declared if high performance standards are not met.
2. In addition, an honorarium of \$700 will be given to the soloist or ensemble that is part of the winning group.

Repertoire Requirements:

1. Instrumental/piano applicants are required to play two pieces showcasing different styles, or two movements showcasing different styles. The program must be 15 to 20 minutes long.
2. Vocal/piano applicants are required to play two works of contrasting style. The program must be 15 to 20 minutes long. Applicants may choose to perform one or two selections if it is a major song cycle.
3. Applicants will be judged on their cohesiveness as well as the rapport of the performers, balance, technique, rhythm, phrasing, quality of tone and style.

Recording Instructions:

1. Must be video recording.
2. Please make sure the video clearly shows both performers.
3. Upload your video(s) to YouTube and make sure the video is set to “public” or “Unlisted”. Include your name and piece name in the title section of the video.
